**Reconfirm instructional delivery method:**

DK - 12 Hybrid and Virtual Academy

**Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:**

Elementary (DK - 5th Grade):

Students have the option to attend school 4 days per week for face-to-face instruction with Wednesday's instruction occurring virtually (Hybrid Model) OR attend the virtual academy.

For in-person instruction, students and staff health and safety will be addressed through a cohort model that keeps students together for the entire day.

Middle School (Grades 6th - 8th):

Students have the option to attend school 4 days per week for face-to-face instruction with Wednesday's instruction occurring virtually (Hybrid Model) OR attend the virtual academy.

For in-person instruction, students and staff health and safety will be addressed through a cohort model that keeps students together for the entire day.

High School (Grades 9th - 12th):

Students will have the option to attend school 4 days per week for face-to-face instruction with Wednesday's instruction occurring virtually (Hybrid Model) OR attend the virtual academy.

For in-person instruction, students and staff health and safety will be addressed through a cohort model that keeps students together for the entire day.

**Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:**

The District is offering the same levels of in-person instruction for students considered special populations as those receiving general education in-person instruction.
