Hello Norse Nation:

Well, the communication piece I was hopeful not to have to send prior to Spring Break is occurring. Starting last week and increasing greatly this week there has been a new Covid uptick in our community and thus impacting our school. We are still in the process of contact tracing. However, we currently have approximately 10% of our student body impacted with a positive test and/or quarantine mandate, have several families pending test results, others leaving each day this week with symptoms that may or may not get tests, and an increasing number choosing to keep their student(s) home for safety precautions. With all of these variables and nothing providing the signal that it will change in the very near future, we have made the decision to go to our Remote Learning Model for next week Monday - Wednesday. Thursday there will not be school and will begin our Spring Break session. This plan is designed to allow us to focus on teaching and learning, rather than on COVID and contact tracing.

Please know, this decision was not made lightly and we fully understand the challenges it poses. I appreciate all of the input we have received from health leadership, staff, our community, and Board.

The following timeline addresses our plan:

Monday, March 29 through Wednesday, March 31

NMPS will operate via remote learning. Your child's teachers will share specifics and questions can be directed to the teacher and/or building principal as needed.

Thursday, April 1 through Sunday, April 11

NMPS will be on Spring Break.

Monday, April 12

We tentatively plan to return to our current system, mirroring what we've done to this point. Further information will follow during Spring Break and closer to our hopeful return.

Our behaviors over Spring Break are crucial to our return to what we all want - our kids in our school learning with their teachers and staff. We all need to be on the same page relative to mitigation strategies. There seems to be no other way for us to move forward; wear a mask, social/physical distance, keep your and your child's in-person social circle small, and wash hands regularly.

Other Impacts:

- Our 2 winter sports teams still involved will move forward with our set safety protocol in place. They will be the only students allowed in the athletic facility next week.
- All spring Sports will be required to participate outdoors only with safety protocols (including after April 2nd the mandated rapid testing) in place.
- Childcare will be following up with families on their plan.

Norse Education Family, now more than ever, we need to look out for each other! I am asking you to please stay positive, caring, trusting, compassionate, and healthy.
